



Appropriate swimwear includes the following: swimming trunks, swimming shorts (including board shorts to the knee), swimming costumes, swimdress, bikini's, tankini's, burkini's, Hijood (or other similar swimwear).

N.B. Under certain circumstances close fitting plain t-shirts may also be worn at the discretion of the Swimming Pool Supervisor.



For under 5's, to help maintain body heat without restricting movement, the following swimwear is also permitted: neoprene baby wraps, knee-length suits, float suits or neoprene 'float jackets' (N.B. Longer than knee/elbow length wet suits are not permitted as they restrict movement).



Inappropriate swimwear includes the following: underwear, transparent costumes or thongs (or anything with obscene or offensive pictures or slogans), sporting wear, denim or cotton leggings/leotards, long flowing clothes, baggy t-shirts, swimwear with protruding designs or accessories that could be abrasive to other swimmers and our slides/attractions e.g. pins, rivets, buckles, zippers, buttons etc.
