Description -

Meeting point – Active Copley Gym Entrance

<u>Difficulty Level</u> – At the start of this walk there are some steep inclines on gravel path but after this is flat throughout. Moderate walk.

Time of Walk - 6.15pm

Distance 2.92km

Not suitable for wheelchair access

The walk will start at the side of Copley High School leading towards public footpath at side of school. Footpath is an uneven gravel path with a moderate incline leading up onto Swineshaw Road. As you arrive on Swineshaw Road first part of the road has no public footpath but is a very low level of traffic and we clear onto housing estate after 50 yards of walking. After clearing this it's onto a housing estate and getting to the bottom of Swineshaw Road we turn right onto Brushes Road. this then leading to the entrance of Stalybridge Country Park.

On entering the Country Park there is a stile entry or a narrow entrance leading onto gravel footpath. We then walk up towards end of gravel path in country park back onto Brushes Road. We then will walk halfway up Brushes Road close to Walkerwood Reservoir to take in the scenery and turn around heading all the way back down Brushes Road. Walkers will need to be aware of local traffic whilst crossing roads and the possibility of dog walkers and other pedestrians.

At the end of Brushes Road walkers will turn left on Huddersfield Road back down to our meeting point to then enjoy watching all participants in the Hell on The Fell stage of Tour of Tameside.

At the end of each walk each person taking part will receive a medal. Not only this but these walks will be great to come together meet new people and socialise with other walkers. Our aim is to bring the community together to be part of such a great and inspiring event.
