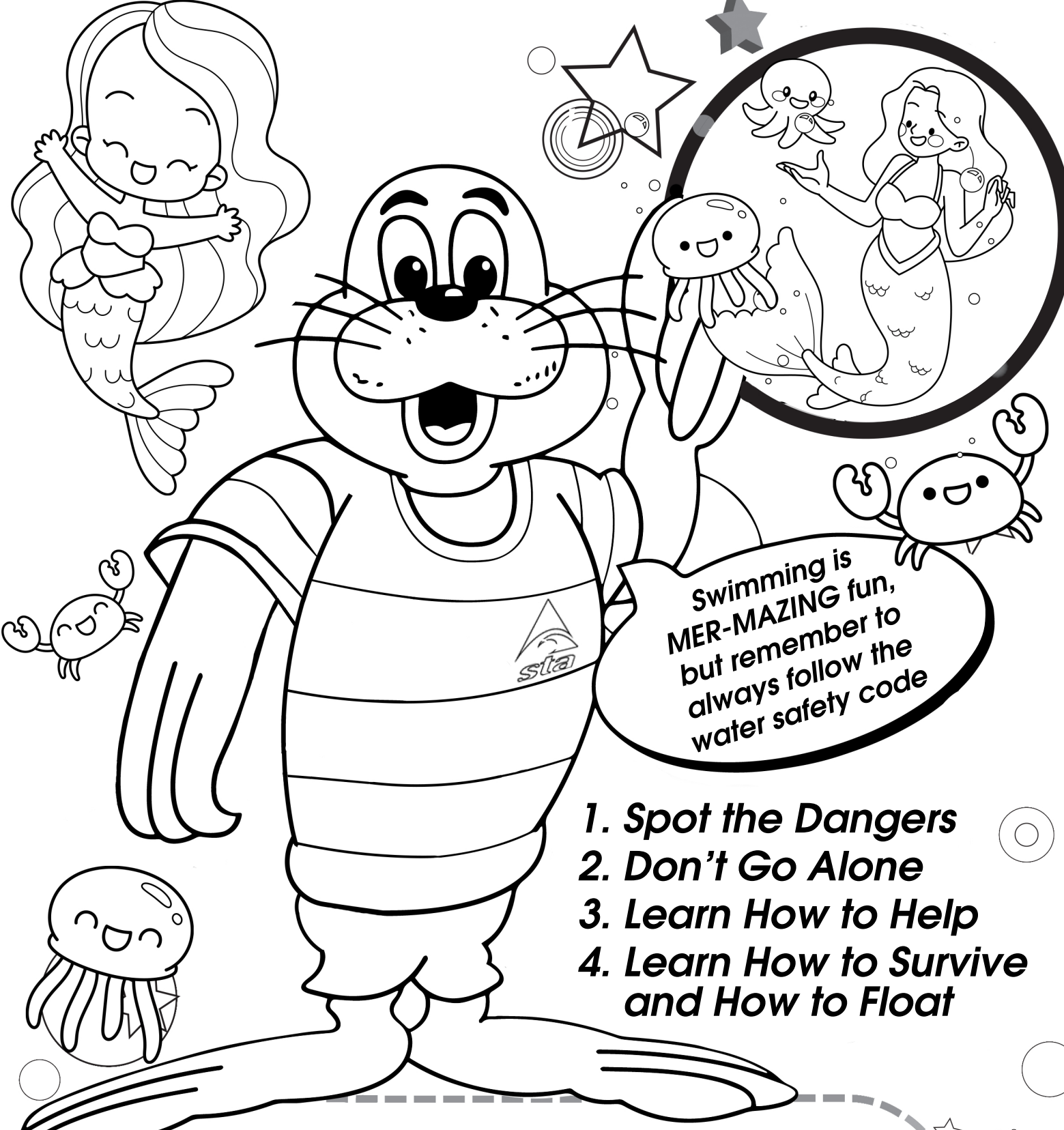
Mermaids are famous for their singing voices, which are said to be very enchanting. They can swim underwater, they come to the surface to breathe air.
